Kelly Addington and Becca Tieder are best friends, educators, idea architects and activists who speak about sexual assault awareness, prevention, and sexual empowerment. Through their appearances and educational resources Kelly and Becca are leading the conversation on consent and sexual empowerment. They speak in simple yet impactful terms, seeking to remove the stigma of victimization and introduce straightforward steps to help reduce sexual violence. Kelly and Becca serve as role models and provide resources for individuals who have experienced the trauma and post-traumatic stress caused by sexual assault as well as those looking to create social change in their community. While many people speak to the issue of sexual assault the reason Kelly and Becca have been so successful is they are the most authentic voice in the movement. Their passion, friendship and humor draw people in- their ability to help transform communities make people fans and loyal clients.

Since 2003, Kelly and Becca have shared their message with over 400 college campuses reaching nearly a million students, and they've worked with various branches of the United States military. The duo has been recognized internationally for their education, outreach and achievements.

impact

In 2009, Kelly and Becca created and produced Sexversations®, an educational tool designed to stimulate difficult conversations about sexuality. That same year, they took control of the No Woman Left Behind Campaign, a nationwide bystander intervention initiative. In 2010 they founded the non-profit organization, One Student, based on their core belief that one sexual assault is too many and one student can make a difference. One Student provides programs, resources and opportunities to create social change and help reduce sexual violence.
